From the Japanese word for fruitwood, Kaju is a collection of 11 items referencing the combination of nature and simplicity in Japanese design. Fruitwood finishes such as pear wood, cherry, plum, and pecan are desirable for their fine, even grain, smooth texture and consistency, often used in today's fine furniture and cabinetry. The collection's clean lines and simple profiles work in harmony with the warm natural wood tones.

The fruitwood palette works well with a wide variety of art and color schemes for its ability to integrate with colorful art and neutral compositions. Kaju provides beautifully simple framing solutions for photography, watercolors, graphic art, drawings, and document framing.
